AOG INTERNATIONAL RELOCATES THEIR HEADQUARTERS TO EIA

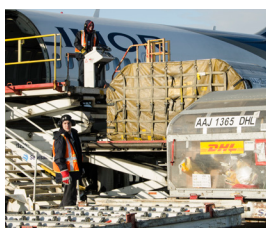

CBSA EXPANDS AND RELOCATES TO EIA CARGO VILLAGE

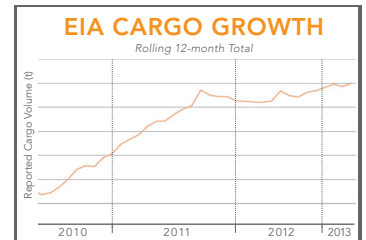
