PREMIUM OUTLET COLLECTION – EDMONTON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Construction is well underway for the Premium Outlet Collection – EIA, developed by Ivanhoé Cambridge and Simon Property Group. The finished 585,000 sq. ft. project is expected to create 1,500 jobs for the region, position EIA as a tourist destination and stimulate further growth on airport lands.

TAPPCAR AND EIA ENTER PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

On June 30, TappCar and Edmonton International Airport finalized an agreement allowing passengers who subscribe to TappCar service to seek transportation through their smartphone for drop-off and pick-up. EIA is the first of Canada's major airports to license a private transportation provider of standard vehicle service (excluding limousines).
